





Ice floats via drone directly to hotel guests:

The Hotel Belvedere Locarno on Monday august 10th, 2015 will provide ice cream to their guests in the hotels garden floating into their hands via a drone.

Milan/Locarno 31.07.2015 - Gone are the "good" old days, where the butler came to serve the guest his favoured ice-cream in a livery. Many times we have seen them humming in the sky and have asked us what this strange thing was up there in the air. In the dark they make rather the appearance of UFOs if one follows the blinking lights. They are actually drones that are so-called unmanned flying objects. They have recently been used in the competition from Google and Amazon for innovative delivery methods and the Hotel Belvedere now wants to use this method for a very special purpose during the famous Locarno Film Festival:

On Monday, August 10th, 2015 exactly halfway through the film festival, whose "Official Partner" Hotel Belvedere is. They plan to offer their hotel-guests an ice cream in the garden. Between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. ice cream will float directly from a professional pilot of the company Multifly into the hosts hand. But that's not all. The airport Milan-Malpensa is positioned 110 km south.
